

## Please review the information below for DoDEA's updated COVID/Respiratory Illness guidance.



- First and foremost, parents are asked to keep sick children at home. Students exhibiting symptoms of an infectious respiratory disease, including colds, influenza, and COVID-19, should not come to school. Students should also continue to practice respiratory illness prevention strategies such as frequent hand washing, covering cough and sneezes, and minimizing close contact with people who are sick.
- A negative COVID-19 test result is not required for a student to return to school following a respiratory infection, nor is there a designated period that students must remain out of school after testing positive and recovering from COVID-19.
- Students returning to school after an absence related to a respiratory illness should consider wearing a mask for ten (10) full days following initial symptoms. Students may wear masks in school at any time based on personal health risks or concerns, or if wishing to reduce the risk of contracting or transmitting a respiratory virus. However, there is no requirement to wear a mask in school.
- Finally, it is important we understand that all DoDEA schools recognize installation or host nation specific measures concerning the spread of infectious respiratory diseases. Installation commanders may take appropriate measures to protect the workforce from and reduce the spread of infectious respiratory diseases. When installation or host nation measures exceed DoD requirements, the applicability of these measures will be communicated with parents.
